- 1) One of the most enriching studies of the Scriptures is a study of the N.T. church.
- 2) Salvation cannot exist outside of Christ's church.

Discussion:

I. The prophecy of the church

- A. The church originated in the mind of God before any part of creation (Eph. 3:10f; 1:3-7; I Pt. 1:10f).
- B. Through the prophets, we learn the specifics of the church's establishment (Dan. 2:44; Isa. 2:2-4; Joel 2:28-32).

II. The preparation for the church

- A. John the Baptizer was a _____ for Christ and His (Christ's) church (Lk. 1:17; Mt. 3:1ff; Mk. 1:2f).
- B. Jesus announced ministry and prepared the coming of His Kingdom (Mt. 4:17; 6:10; 16:18f).
- C. The disciples were taught about the Kingdom (Mt. 6:33; 7:13f; Mk. 9:35-37; Jn. 3:3-7; Mk. 16:16; Jn. 18:36;).

III. The presence of the church

- A. Christ's church was established in _____ on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:47).
- B. From Pentecost forward, the church has been present (Rom. 16:16).
- C. In the epistles, Paul described Christ's church as the body (Rom. 12:4-5; I Cor. 10:17; 12:12, 27; Eph. 4:12; 5:23, 30; Col. 1:24).
- D. She is the bride of Christ (Rev. 21:9; 19:7f; Eph. 5:31f).
- E. The family of God (II Cor. 6:18; Mt. 12:49f; Eph. 2:19; Gal. 6:10).
- F. The house of God (I Timothy 3:14f; I Pt. 4:17).
- G. The temple of God, built with living stones (I Cor. 3:11; Eph. 2:19-22; I Pt. 2:5-7; I Cor. 3:16f).

IV. The position of the church.

- A. "I will be there God and they shall be my people" (II Cor. 6:16).
- B. The church of Christ will never be destroyed (Dan. 2:44-45; Dan. 7:13f; Mt. 16:13-18).
- C. In eternity, Christ's church will live (I Cor. 15:24; I Thess. 4:13-18).

Introduction:

- 1) Genesis 1 – The spiritual side of man (Genesis 1:26f).
- 2) Genesis 2 – The physical side of man (Genesis 2:7, 21-22).
- 3) Genesis 3 – The battle between spirit and flesh of man (Genesis 3:1, 6).
- 4) This morning our study surrounds the question asked by God – "Where Are You?"

Discussion:

I. Some observations before the Fall (The environment).

- A. Everything that God had created was very good (Genesis 1:31).
- B. God prepared a Garden in Eden for man to live (Genesis 2:8ff).
 - 1) It was a _____ place (Genesis 2:9a).
 - 2) It provided food for man's nourishment (Genesis 2:9b, 10-14)
 - 3) It was the home for two of the most important trees in history (Genesis 2:9c; 1:29).
 - a) Tree of Life
 - b) Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil
 - 4) It was a place for man's purpose (Genesis 2:15; 1:28f).
 - 5) It was a place that required _____ to God (Genesis 2:16; Genesis 3:8).
 - 6) It was the place where God joined Adam and Eve in marriage (Genesis 2:18ff).
 - 7) It was a place where sin was not present for a time.

II. The origin of Satan and his influence.

- A. What we know:
 - 1) Satan is not an eternal being (Gen. 1:1, 26f; John 1:1-3; Matthew 28:19).
 - 2) He is not a physical being, therefore, a part of the angelic host (Colossians 1:16; Hebrews 1:14).
 - 3) Given the freedom to choose, he rebelled against God, and was cast out (I Timothy 3:6f; II Peter 2:4; Jude 1:6; Matthew 25:41).

- B. Contextually, Satan worked through the _____ (Genesis 3:1; II Corinthians 11:2-3; II Corinthians 11:14).
- C. He actively works against and through God's special creation to gain more followers (John 8:44; I John 3:8; I Peter 5:8).

III. The Fall of Man.

- A. Satan challenges God's command (Genesis 3:1b).
- B. Satan changes God's word (Genesis 3:4; 2:17).
- C. Satan concentrates on the forbidden tree (Genesis 3:5).
- D. Satan captures Eve through her lusts (Genesis 3:6; I John 2:15-17).
 - 1) The lust of the flesh – Eve "saw that the tree was good for food."
 - 2) The lust of the eyes – Eve saw "that it was pleasant to the eyes."
 - 3) The pride of life – Eve saw that it was "to be desired to make one wise."
- E. Satan controls Adam through his wife (Genesis 3:6b, 17; I Timothy 2:13-14; Matthew 10:37).
- F. Satan created great separation (Genesis 3:9ff).
 - 1) Man separated from _____ (3:10).
 - 2) Man separated from his wife (3:12).
 - 3) Man separated from his God (3:12).
 - 4) Man separated from his environment (3:22-24).
- G. The consequences because of the Fall.
 - 1) The serpent and Satan were punished (Genesis 3:14f).
 - 2) Woman was punished (Genesis 3:16).
 - 3) The Man was punished (Genesis 3:17-19).
 - 4) The possibility to live forever through the Tree of Life was cut off from all mankind (Genesis 3:22ff).
