 - D. Some were present to see that He "paid" for His "crimes" (Mt. 27:36f).
 - E. Those passing by were there to insult Him (Mt. 27:39-44).
 - F. Some disciples of Jesus were at the Cross (Mt. 27:55f; Jn. 19:25-27).
 - G. At the end, Jesus said, " _____ " (John 19:30)!

 - A. The physical location of Jesus' Cross (Jn. 19:20; Heb. 13:12-13; Mt. 27:33).
 - B. "Was it not necessary for the Christ to suffer these things and then to enter His glory" (Lk. 24:26)?
 - C. His Cross may not be standing today, but consider where He is right now (Heb. 12:2).
 - D. The Old Rugged Cross

 - A. The Christian light illuminates from Christ and the Bible (Psa. 119:105; Psa. 119:130; Jn. 17:17; I Jn. 1:5-7; Jn. 8:12; 3:19-21).

 - B. Internally, consider where you are right now (II Cor. 13:5).
 - C. Determine to stay positive in your service for the LORD (Rom. 12:11).
 - D. Do something each day for the Lord and His church (I Cor. 15:58; Rev. 14:13).
 - E. Don't grow weary in doing good (Gal. 6:9f).
 - F. Share your flame with others (Heb. 10:24; II Tim. 2:2).
