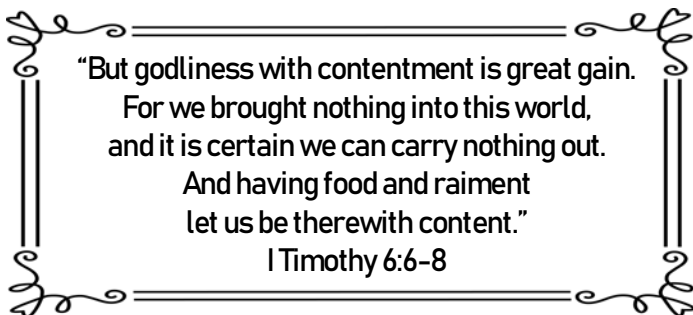

Discussion:

I. The problem.

- A. Man has devised his own path of morality and happiness (Jer. 10:23; II Tim. 4:3-4; Rom. 1:18, 28).
- B. The privileges exclusive to marriage have been defiled (Heb. 13:4).
- C. Men and women are leaving God out of their joining (Gen. 2:18ff; Mt. 19:4-6).

II. Some thoughts through example.

- B. Sexual sin in the church (I Cor. 5:1ff).
 - 1) Corinth has become puffed up about it (I Cor. 5:2).
 - 2) When sin continues in one's life, he must be delivered back to Satan (I Cor. 5:5-7).
 - 3) Fellowship has been severed (I Cor. 5:9, 11, 13).
