FOCUS: The Godhead

God, the Father

Ephesians 4:6

Introduction:

- 1) Life consists of one major decision: What am I going to do with God?
- 2) Currently, our world doesn't appear to know HOW to respond to God.
- 3) Considering the evidence for God is key to understanding and believing (Rom. 10:17; Heb. 11:1).

Discussion:

I. God is Creator.

- A. "In the _____, God created the heaven and the earth" (Gen. 1:1).
- B. David declared of this truth (Psa. 19:1-6; 8:3).
- C. Through creation, God reveals Himself (Rom. 1:19-20, 21-23).

II. God is Intelligent.

- A. God is not a glorified "it" (Jn. 4:23-24).
 - 1) He is the "living God and true God" (Josh. 3:10; I Thess. 1:9; I Tim. 3:15).
 - 2) He has life Himself and gives life to all (Jn. 5:26; Acts 27:25).
 - 3) He is the living Father (Jn. 6:57).
- B. He is eternal and _____ changes (Rev. 1:8; Tit. 1:2; Heb. 6:18; 13:8; II Pt. 3:8; Jam. 1:17).
- C. Human design points to His intelligence (Gen. 1:26f; Acts 17:28f; II Pt. 2:12).

III. God is the Only God.

- A. He is the _____ God (Isa. 44:6; Jn. 17:3; I Tim. 1:17; Eph. 4:6; Deut. 6:4).
- B. The fact that God commanded, "You shall have no other gods before Me" does NOT signify the reality of other gods (Ex. 20:3).
- C. There is only ONE God (Isa. 46:9; Jam. 2:19).

IV. God is Sustainer

- A. God is love (I Jn. 4:8; Jn. 3:16).
- B. He is the perfect gift giver (Jam. 1:17; Eph. 2:8; Rom. 6:23).
- C. Through His name and authority, we become a disciple of Christ in baptism (Mt. 28:19).

God is...

Spirit

God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth (Jn. 4:24).

Love

He who does not love does not know God, for God is love (I Jn. 4:8).

Light

This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that God is light and in Him is no darkness at all (I Jn. 1:5).

Holy

But as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy" (I Pt. 1:15-16).

Faithful

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear (I Cor. 10:13).

Able

And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work (II Corinthians 9:8).

Righteous

For the LORD is righteous, He loves righteousness; His countenance beholds the upright (Psalm 11:7).

These are only a few of the "God is..." passages of the Bible. Will you take a moment and find some others to add to the list? Jesus' prayed to the Father, "And this is eternal life, that they

may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent" (John 17:3). What are you doing to know the Father?

An Idol is Nothing

I Corinthians 8

Introduction:

- 1) I Corinthians 8:6 – "But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him."
- 2) The fourth major problem facing the Corinthian brethren was eating meat sacrificed to idols (I Corinthians 8:1).

Discussion:

I. Love over knowledge.

- A. "Now concerning things offered to idols" (I Cor. 8:1a).
- B. Knowledge _____ up, but love builds up (I Cor. 8:1c).
- C. Paul's questioners already knew everything, or so they thought (I Cor. 8:1-2, 10).
- D. God knows those who belong to Him (I Cor. 8:3; II Tim. 2:19).

II. Eating of things offered to idols

- A. WE _____ that an idol is nothing in the world (I Cor. 8:4)
- B. There is only one God and one Lord (I Cor. 8:4-6; Eph. 4:4-6).
- C. Not everyone has knowledge that idols are nothing (I Cor. 8:7).
- D. Weaker conscience is equated to a lack of spiritual maturity (I Cor. 8:7-8).
- E. In such cases, we need to be cautious not to be a stumbling block for the brethren (I Cor. 8:9-11).
- F. So as to be a stepping stone and not a stumbling block, Paul said he would _____ eating meat for his brethren (I Cor. 8:13).

III. Applications

- A. Doing what one has the right to do is not always best.
- B. To what extent do we love our brethren?
- C. In Christ, we have been set free (Jn. 8:32; Rom. 6:17; Gal. 5:1-4; I Pt. 2:16; I Thess. 5:13).
