The Holy Spirit of God

Introduction:

- 1) The Holy Spirit is one of the most misunderstood persons of the Godhead.
- 2) The Holy Spirit needs to be understood as much as the Father and Son.

Discussion:

- I. **Common Misunderstandings Concerning the Holy Spirit.**
 - A. His **character** is misunderstood because proper study has not been given to the Holy Spirit.
 - B. His _____ is misapplied because some have “heaped up doctrines” of their own accord (II Pt. 3:16-18).
 - C. His **influence** is mistaken because some want to make His first century interactions with the church twenty first century interactions.
- II. **His Presence.**
 - A. In the Old Testament
 - 1) Mentioned 88 times in 23 of the O.T. books
 - 2) _____ times referenced as the “Holy Spirit” (Psa. 51:11; Isa. 63:11-12).
 - 3) He was present at Creation (Genesis 1:2; Psa. 104:30; Job 33:4).
 - B. In the New Testament
 - 1) Mentioned _____ times in the N.T.
 - 2) The One Spirit (Eph. 4:4; Lk. 24:39); He is God (Acts 5:3-4).
 - C. In the life of Christ
 - 1) His birth (Isa. 7:14; Mt. 1:20; Lk. 1:30-35).
 - 2) His baptism (Mt. 3:16; Mk. 1:10; Jn. 1:32-34).
 - 3) His temptation (Mt. 4:1; Mk. 1:12; Lk. 4:1).
 - 4) His ministry (Lk. 4:14-21; Mt. 12:28).
 - D. In the life of the Apostles
 - 1) The limited commission (Mt. 10:1, 20).
 - 2) Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit to the _____ (Jn. 14:16, 26; 15:26; 16:13).
 - 3) When Jesus appeared before His final ascension, He confirmed the Spirit’s coming (Acts 1:5, 8)
 - 4) Acts 2:1-4, the Apostles receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

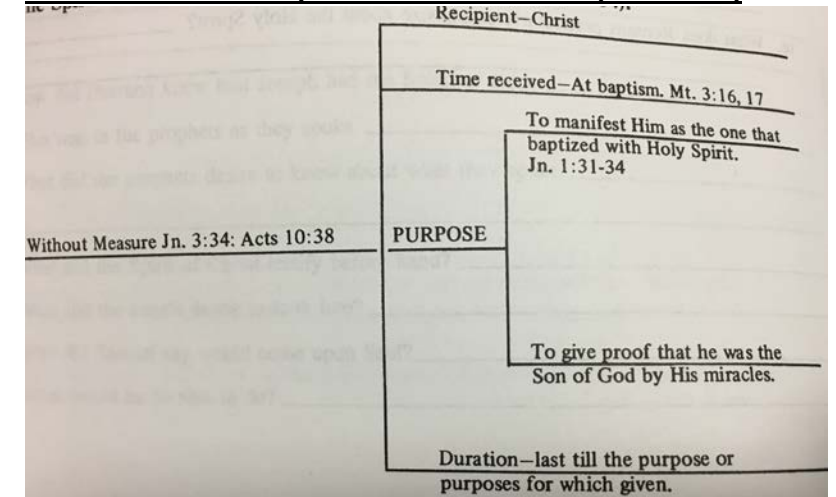
- a) They spoke as the Spirit gave them utterance (2:4).
 - b) He reminded them of the prophesy of Joel 2:28-30; Acts 2:17-21.
 - c) He directed them to “Repent and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins” (Acts 2:38).
 - d) Upon which, Jesus pronounced the authority of such to also be given not only by God, and the Son, but also the Holy Spirit Himself (Mt. 28:19)!
- E. In the Scriptures
- 1) Brought forth the Word (II Pt. 1:20-21).
 - 2) Teaches and reveals the Word (I Cor. 2:10-13).
 - 3) Confirmed the Word (Mk. 16:16-20; Heb. 2:3-4).
 - 4) Eph. 6:17/II Tim. 3:16f
- III. **The Benefit for Christians.**
- A. The Spirit also helps in our weaknesses in prayer (Rom. 8:26-27).
 - B. He bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God (Rom. 8:16-17).
 - 1) The witness of the Holy Spirit quoting Jeremiah’s prophecy (Heb. 10:15-17; Jer. 31:31-34).
 - 2) The Spirit served as a witness to the seven churches of Asia through John (Rev. 1:11, 27).
 - 3) The Spirit bears witness with our spirit that we have done what is necessary to become a Christian.
 - a) Hear (Jn. 6:44-45)
 - b) Believe (Heb. 11:6)
 - c) Repent (Lk. 13:3)
 - d) Confess (Rom. 10:10)
 - e) Baptized (Acts 2:38).
 - 4) We are children of God when we learn to live and walk by the Spirit of God (Gal. 5:16-24).
 - C. He helps us transform into the image of Jesus (II Cor. 3:18).
 - D. He strengthens the inner man and seals us (Eph. 3:14-19; II Cor. 4:16; I Pt. 3:4; Eph. 1:13f).

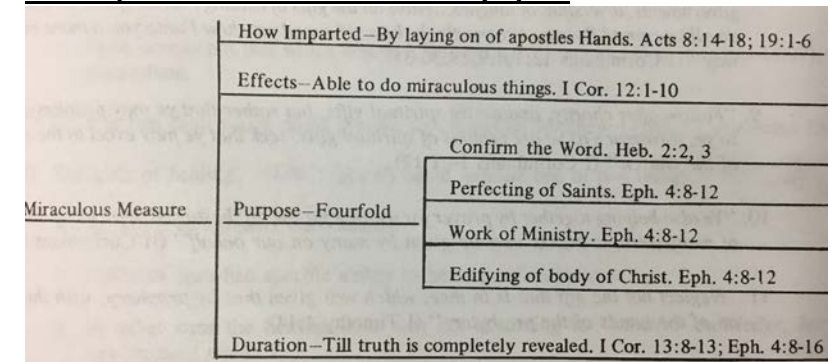

Charts from James Meadows: Holy Spirit Study

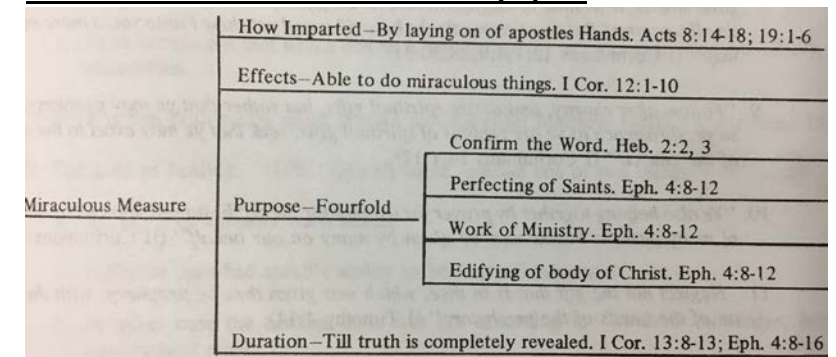
Christ received the Spirit without measure (John 3:34)
