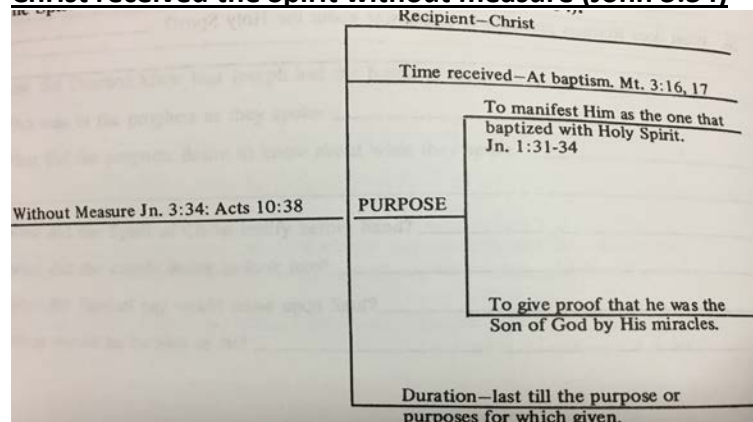

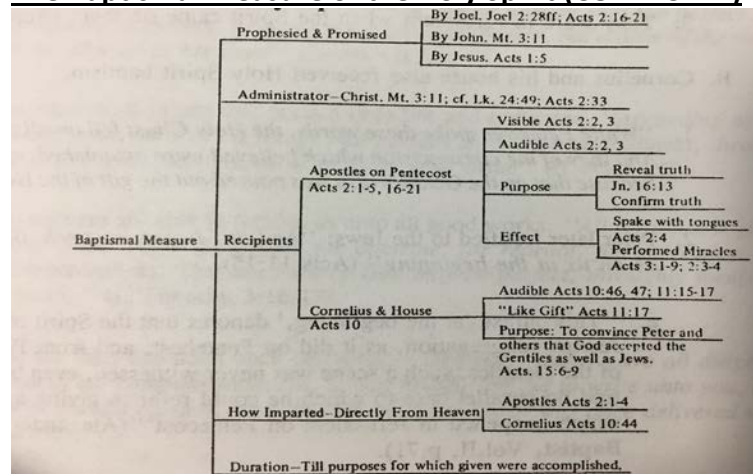
Measures of the Holy Spirit

Charts from James Meadows: Holy Spirit Study

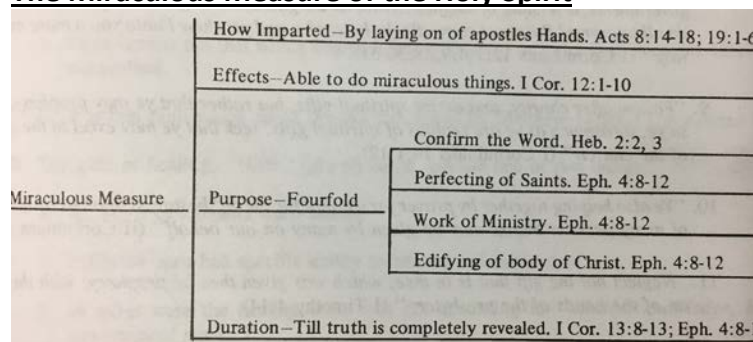
Christ received the Spirit without measure (John 3:34)

Brother Meadows, in a fourth point, illustrates the ordinary measure (non-miraculous) of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38; 5:32; I Cor. 6:19).

Avoiding the Pitfalls of Temptation

I Corinthians 10

Introduction:

- 1) "Moreover" reminds us to connect Paul's previous discussion to what he is about to share with the Corinthian brethren (I Cor. 10:1a).
- 2) Paul was about to introduce something very important.

Discussion:

I. Avoid Israel's mistakes (I Cor. 10:1-11).

- A. Note the point of emphasis - "ALL" (10:1-4).
 - 1) "ALL our fathers were under the _____" (Ex. 13:21-22).
 - 2) "ALL passed through the sea" (Ex. 14:21-22).
 - 3) "ALL were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea" (Ex. 14:30-31).
 - 4) "ALL ate the same spiritual food" (Ex. 16:4, 15, 18).
 - 5) "ALL drank the same spiritual drink" (Ex. 17:5-6; Num. 20:10-11; I Cor. 10:4b; Deut. 2:7; Jn. 4:14; Jn. 6:35).
- B. It is then recorded, "But with **most** of them God was not well pleased, for their bodies were scattered in the wilderness" (I Cor. 10:5; Num. 14:30; Deut. 1:34-38; Heb. 3:16-19; Jude 1:5).
- C. "Now these things became our examples..." (I Cor. 10:6-11; Num. 11:4, 34; I Thess. 5:22).
 - 1) "Do not become idolaters as were some of them" (Ex. 32:1, 4, 19, Col. 3:5).
 - 2) "Nor let us commit sexual immorality, as some of them did" (Ex. 32:6; Num. 25:1-3, 9).
 - 3) "Nor let us _____ Christ, as some of them also tempted" (Num. 21:4-5; Mt. 4:7).
 - 4) "No complaints, as some of them also complained" (Ex. 16:2, 8).

II. "All these things ... were written for our admonition..." (I Cor. 10:12-14).

- A. It is far better to learn from the mistakes of others than our own.
- B. We are warned through these examples not to be over-confident (I Cor. 10:12).
- C. No one in the flesh is exempt from temptation (I Cor. 10:13).
- D. God is faithful (Hebrews 2:18; I Cor. 10:13).
- E. Therefore, "flee from idolatry" (I Cor. 10:14).
