How Do You Listen to a Sermon?

How do you listen to a sermon? Do you sit idly, anxious for the preacher to quit talking (Hebrews 5:11)? Do you eagerly search to find the truth (Acts 17:11)? Do you judge the preacher's ability to smooth talk and place him in competition with his fellow preachers in the Kingdom (I Corinthians 1:12-13; Philippians 2:3-4)?

God uses preachers as vessels for the proclamation of His truth (Romans 10:14ff; John 17:17). This responsibility must not be taken lightly, nor should we disrespect the difficult work preachers do.

Every lesson, when properly prepared, ought to point each listener to the Word of God. When the gospel is proclaimed, the most important message the world can hear is represented.

The words stated about Ezra are true of most gospel preachers; "For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the Law of the LORD, and to do it, and to teach statutes and ordinances in Israel" (Ezra 7:10).

In the days of Ezra, he among others, "gave the sense, and helped them to understand the reading" (Nehemiah 8:7-8). Every gospel preacher wants everyone to understand the Word of God.

Don't miss the purpose of a sermon. The preacher is only there to point you to one thing - and it's not himself. "He who has ears to hear, let him hear!"
